This includes abiding by the ten great principles of His eternal law. It includes responsible stewardship of all that He has entrusted to us – our possessions, of which we return a tithe as well as offerings; and our bodies, which we attempt to maintain in the best possible condition through the principles of health He has given. It also includes Christian modesty in deportment and dress, as well as avoiding any amusements or entertainment that would tend to draw our hearts away from Christ rather than leading us closer to Him. And finally, it includes a commitment to share the gospel wherever we have influence through our financial support of missions and evangelism, through our own personal testimony and witness, and through the use of spiritual gifts we have been given by the Holy Spirit for the building up of Christ’s body on earth, the church.

Our commitment to our Lord is publicly demonstrated and symbolized through baptism by immersion, and by continuing participation regularly in the divine services of the Lord’s Supper and the Ordinance of Humility.
